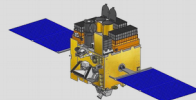


# Science with Ultra Violet Imaging Telescope



UVIT, the ultraviolet eye of ASTROSAT completed one and a half year of observations. The telescope is taking UV data of the Universe at a resolution better than 1.5 arc sec. UVIT is expected to make significant contribution to galactic and extra galactic astronomy. A two day meeting to discuss the initial science results from UVIT will be organized on 6-7, July, 2017 at Indian Institute of Astrophysics, Bangalore.
